Important Updates:

- Reminder Per the WA State Department of Health, face masks/coverings are required for indoor public settings and/or when outdoors and unable to maintain 6 feet of physical distance from others, in order to help prevent the spread of the coronavirus.

- Gov. Jay Inslee issued a proclamation related to the DSHS Family Emergency Assistance Program
 (FEAP). DSHS is authorized to expand eligibility for the FEAP to include individuals and families
 without children. This proclamation is effective immediately and will expire at the end of the state

- Businesses statewide will not be able to serve visitors who are not wearing face masks, and are directed to require and enforce the use of face coverings, per Gov. Jay Inslee's extension of the Safe Start proclamation. Businesses risk closure and potential business license revocation.
